ACADEMIC REQUIREMENT

- Obtained 2 GCE 'O' Levels passes *English and any 1 subject or equivalent; Or
- Nitec, Higher Nitec or equivalent; Or
- Matured student: At least 30 years old with at least 8 years of relevant working experiences will be considered.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

- *A pass in English at GCE 'O' Level, or IELTS 5.5 and or equivalent; Or
- Completed a prior Diploma or equivalent where the medium of instruction is English

NOTES

- Industrial Attachment is a compulsory component of the programme. Students are required to complete a 6-month full-time attachment with an approved industry partner. Placement may be arranged by the school or secured by the student, subject to the school's approval.
- The industrial attachment is assessed through employer evaluation and the submission of a report or project.
- In the event that a student is unable to secure or be placed in an industrial attachment due to circumstances beyond the control of the student or the institution (e.g. non-approval of Training Work Permit), the student will be required to complete an Industrial Project (3000 words) under the supervision of a lecturer.
- The industrial project (3000 words) topic must be relevant to the event/tourism/hospitality industry and approved by the school. Students have a maximum of 2 months to complete the project after approval. The Industrial Project provides an opportunity for students to integrate their knowledge through application to a practical based classroom project within the selection of the student's choice of industry. Preferably, this project focuses on an identified management issues and/or opportunity of an organisation.
