# DIPLOMA (SPECIALIZED IN INTERNATIONAL HOSPITALITY AND HOTEL MANAGEMENT)

Before the COVID-19 pandemic, the number of visitors to Singapore and the hotel room occupancy rate reached a record high. Although the hotel industry has been experiencing an unprecedented challenge around the world since 2020, with vaccination campaigns launched in many countries last year, it is expected that the industry will be recovered gradually in the foreseeable future, and the subsequent demand for qualified manpower will become strong again in the local and international hotel industries. The course is designed to provide foundation knowledge that covers specific features of hospitality and hotel industries in the local and international context. This theoretical groundwork precedes a hands-on industry attachment, providing real-world exposure, industry practices, and professional networks. The immersive experience deepens understanding of the hospitality and hotel sector, enhancing leadership, management, and customer service skills for diverse careers in hospitality. In the event of not completing the industry attachment, students will be required to prepare and submit an industry project within 2 months, ensuring they still demonstrate practical knowledge and skills relevant to the field.

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## ACADEMIC REQUIREMENT

- Obtained 2 GCE 'O' Levels passes \*English and any 1 subject or equivalent; Or
- Nitec, Higher Nitec or equivalent; Or
- Matured student: At least 30 years old with at least 8 years of relevant working experiences will be considered.

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

- \* A pass in English at GCE 'O' Level, or IELTS 5.5 and/or equivalent; Or
- Completed a prior Diploma or equivalent where the medium of instruction is English

## NOTES

- Industrial Attachment is a compulsory component of the programme. Students are required to complete a 6-month full-time attachment with an approved industry partner. Placement may be arranged by the school or secured by the student, subject to the school's approval.
- The industrial attachment is assessed through employer evaluation and the submission of a report or project.
- In the event that a student is unable to secure or be placed in an industrial attachment due to circumstances beyond the control of the student or the institution (e.g. non-approval of Training Work Permit), the student will be required to complete an Industrial Project (3000 words) under the supervision of a lecturer.
- The industrial project (3000 words) topic must be relevant to the hospitality/ hotel industry and approved by the school. Students have a maximum of 2 months to complete the project after approval. The Industrial Project provides an opportunity for students to integrate their knowledge through application to a practical based classroom project within the selection of the student's choice of industry. Preferably, this project focuses on an identified management issues and/or opportunity of an organisation.
