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## ACADEMIC REQUIREMENT

- Obtained 2 GCE 'O' Levels passes \*English and any 1 subject or equivalent; OR
- Nitec, Higher Nitec or equivalent; OR
- Completion of GSTM Professional Certificate in English for Tourism and Hospitality Management or Equivalent; OR
- Matured student: At least 30 years old with at least 8 years of relevant working experiences will be considered.

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

- \*A pass in English at GCE 'O' Level, or IELTS 4.5 and or equivalent; OR
- Completed a prior Diploma or equivalent where the medium of instruction is English

## NOTE

- Industrial Attachment is an integral part of the course. In the unlikely event that a student cannot be placed for Industrial Attachment, due to circumstances beyond the control of the student or the college, like non-approval of the Training Work Permit by Ministry of Manpower, the student will be required to complete an Industrial Project (3000 words) under the supervision of a lecturer from GSTM.
- The industrial project (3000 words) topic must be relevant to the tourism/hospitality industry and approved by the school. Students have a maximum of 2 months to complete the project after approval. The Industrial Project provides an opportunity for students to integrate their knowledge through application to a practical based classroom project within the selection of the student's choice of industry. Preferably, this project focuses on an identified management issues and/or opportunity of an organisation.
