

GSTM Personal Data Notice for Students

(Last updated: 31 October 2023)

- 1) The Global School of Technology and Management ("GSTM") administers undergraduate and graduate courses. In doing so, GSTM collects, uses, discloses, and processes personal data of enrolled students ("Students") for the following purposes:
 - a) Enrollment in and provision of courses, materials, and relevant information.
 - b) Administration of the Student's relationship with GSTM.
 - c) Due diligence, background checks, and obtaining references.
 - d) Handling inquiries from Students.
 - e) Processing scholarship and financial aid applications, as well as alumni engagement.
 - f) Ensuring safety, security, and investigations.
 - g) Responding to requests from authorities.
 - h) Conducting research for operational strategy and policy planning.
 - i) Alumni outreach and engagement.
 - j) Participation in promotional materials and events.
 - k) Sharing information with other educational institutions and companies.
 - l) Overseas programs and awards.
 - m) Administration of awards and distinctions.
 - n) Alumni engagement after graduation.
 - o) Career-related activities and opportunities.
 - p) Student life and development opportunities.
 - q) Cross-cultural adjustment and orientation.
 - r) Marketing and promotional materials.
 - s) Photography and videography for publicity.
 - t) Support for health and well-being.

- 2) GSTM may disclose the Student's personal data to third-party service providers for the aforementioned purposes.

- 3) The Student consents to GSTM collecting, using, disclosing, and processing their personal data for the stated purposes and transferring it to third-party service providers.

- 4) The Student is responsible for ensuring the accuracy and truthfulness of their personal data and obtaining consent from others before disclosing their personal data to GSTM.

- 5) This notice is part of the Acceptance Record with GSTM.
